



Janis ECO B&C Organic Straw Pellets

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Straw pellets are a high-performance bedding material with a moisture absorption capacity of up to 500%.

Organic straw pellets differ from intensively farmed cereal straw in that they are **100% chemical-free** and naturally contain 5–10% mixed natural grasses (including wild plants). The natural grass within the pellets provides a pleasant aroma in the stable and suppresses urine odors.

The straw is thoroughly shredded twice before being compressed into pellets. The firmness of the pellets is specifically engineered to allow them to break down easily and quickly, creating a soft and comfortable bedding surface for the horse.

Recommended Application in the Stall

- **Concrete Floors:** Apply a layer of pellets approximately 5 cm deep across the floor.
- **Rubber Matting:** Apply half the amount used for concrete floors (approximately 2.5 cm deep).
- **Activation:** To help the pellets break down faster and form a soft bedding layer, moisten them with water using at least 1 liter of water per 5 kg of pellets.
- **Settling:** Not all pellets will break down immediately; the horse will naturally break down the remaining pellets as it moves around the stall.
- **Maintenance & Efficiency:** The main advantage of straw pellets is that manure and urine can be easily separated from the clean bedding. Stalls should be cleaned regularly (preferably daily).
- **Replenishment:** Top up the bedding based on the amount removed during cleaning.
- **Refilling:** Replacement pellets can either be moistened beforehand or simply spread into the stall, where they will mix with the existing broken-down layer.

Important Safety Information

Please Note:

Because organic straw pellets contain natural grass, horses may attempt to taste the unbroken pellets. Food-grade oil is used for granulator lubrication, meaning the only potential risk to the horse is from ingesting un-dissolved pellets.

- **Monitor the horse's behavior closely** when introducing them to the new bedding.
- **Store straw pellets** in a separate storage room or an area where horses cannot freely access them.
- **Personal Responsibility:** The horse owner assumes full personal responsibility for their horse.
